Radiologists interpret imaging studies to help detect, diagnose, and monitor a wide range of medical conditions. Some also perform image-guided procedures (interventional radiology).

Key Responsibilities

- Analyze medical images (X-ray, CT, MRI, ultrasound)
 - Prepare detailed diagnostic reports for referring physicians
 - Perform image-guided procedures (biopsies, drainages, etc.)
 - Ensure accurate and safe use of imaging equipment
 - Consult with doctors to recommend appropriate imaging tests
 - Monitor patient progress through follow-up imaging
 - Hands-on exposure in USG, X-Ray, MRI/CT, and Interventional Radiology

Types of Radiologists

- **Diagnostic Radiologist** – Focuses on interpreting imaging
 - **Interventional Radiologist** – Performs minimally invasive procedures using imaging guidance
 - **Neuroradiologist** – Specializes in brain and nervous system imaging
 - **Pediatric Radiologist** – Works with children
